



CEFAM was the only school I applied to get into. I met some of the CEFAM team at a school fair in Southern France, Senior year in high-school. The unique American based program and model, topped by the fact that you have the opportunity to study abroad and graduate from an American University is what drew me towards choosing CEFAM. When I first applied to get in, I was not accepted due to my poor English. I went to the UK and spent a few months immersed, getting more comfortable with the language, and returned to take the entry exam

again, successfully this time. CEFAM truly was the only school that spoke to me.

The involvement of not only the professors, but the staff as well was wonderful. All following your journey along and helping you in any way they can. From assignments, to finding internships, College recommendation and career goals, the staff and professors were always available to guide me in the direction that made most sense for me and was in line with my goals.

Being exposed to the "real world" is invaluable: Turning theory into practice, seeing how crucial basic business knowledge is in the workplace, being faced with challenges other than having a paper due in a couple of days, feeling "the heat" of performing well and earning a paycheck. If I had to give any advice to students looking for internships now, I would try to find an internship that would challenge me and push me out of my comfort zone a bit – rather than taking the easy route.

After graduating from CEFAM and Temple University in 2009, I worked for a German company as Assistant Manager at the Philadelphia International Airport. Because of the company culture, company structure and the service we were providing, this position taught me the "getting down and dirty" ropes of managing people, budgets, and being held accountable for the performance of the location. I then moved on to managing a US network of installers for my current employer, Endlesspools. I was in this role for a year before moving to Washington DC. In DC I was going through my certification on helping government and corporate buildings get their Green status (through construction stages and then management of the upkeep of the buildings). 9 months later, I was back at Endlesspools after they offered me a newly opened position in the International Sales Department. This position is where I knew "this is where I belong". I was promoted from International Account Manager to International Business Development Manager 2 years later. I stayed in the role of International Business Development Manager the next 4+years.

My current title and job is International Sales Manager. I oversee the international sales department for the world leader in aquatic exercise and swimming pools, Endlesspools. Some of my responsibilities are to drive my team of business development managers and account managers to deliver the results our company has committed to to our parent company, MASCO, a publicly traded company and Fortune 500. From establishing strategies (including product, marketing, sales, finance and more) to implementing them, working at the macro and micro level is a very exciting aspect of my responsibilities. Going after new markets like China, understanding the culture and what the market can bare, how to go about taking our products to market there, who are the players we want to partner with, and then implementing and auditing the results, is my idea of fun! Managing personnel, assessing risks that could cost millions of dollars to the company are also part of the job. Things aren't always pretty, but I got ready for it the 3 years I attended CEFAM. The aggressiveness in the way business is done and companies are run in the US is something that always appealed to me. CEFAM was a great way to get ready to enter this work environment and culture. If I had to do it all over again, I would!

After completing a BTS (2 year undergraduate) course in International Business, I joined CEFAM in 1993 for a year in Lyon and then one year in ODU, Norfolk, to get my bachelor level in management and marketing.

Recruited by the campus the night before graduating, I worked one year in the U.S. in sales management thanks to a working visa. Then I returned to Paris for five years and worked in two small companies. First, I worked as head of marketing in a small business in the entertainment and leisure sector. Then I was hired by QUINTESS as the key account manager, focusing on customer loyalty. This company sponsored me to get an MBA at the Oxford Said Business School in 2001. There, I worked two years as a strategic director for European business expansion. Later I discovered the world of social entrepreneurship when I joined ETHICAL PROPERTY where I worked for 6 years. I returned to France in 2010 where I adapted this model to my creation of the Etic Company (www.etic.co).

Eight years later, the employees of ETIC are managing eight eco-friendly work spaces in six different cities which host the offices and business of 250 organizations that are selected based on their emphasis on fair trade, environmental sustainability and social awareness. The CEO Award truly motivated the ETIC team and I am quite proud to have shared those moments with them. This recognition allowed me to strengthen my resolve and determination to experience the highs and lows that come with the entrepreneurial adventure.


Getting an American/Canadian bachelor of business and a certified level 7 diploma is in your hands.

With CEFAM join an American university to obtain your BBA from an accredited AACSB business school.

At the end of your curriculum you will simultaneously obtain:

- The bachelor of business administration (BBA) delivered by an AACSB accredited university where you studied during your fourth year.
- The nationally certified level 7 CEFAM diploma International business management (registered the 21/04/2017 in the RNCP Official journal, Code NSF 310m).

If you choose to spend your 4th year studying at CEFAM and if you fulfill your 6 month internship in an English speaking country, you will graduate with the CEFAM state certified level 7 diploma. After getting the certified level 7 CEFAM diploma at the end of your 4th year, you have the possibility to join a Partnered American university to graduate with an MBA.

^{*} The "Career Research and Development" course module includes a mandatory 3-month internship as well as a written report and professional presentation during the semester that follows the internship. This course also includes conferences, workshops, and guest speakers organized throughout the academic year to help students prepare their individual career paths.

^{*} The "Career Planning and Management" course module includes the 6-month internship that is mandatory for all CEFAM students. A written report and professional presentation are required of all students during the semester that follows the internship. This course module also includes multiple workshops organized throughout the year.

How much do you know about the BBA and MBA degrees? The Bachelor and Master of Business Administration degrees are the standard in business education in the United States. Based on a modular academic format that incorporates enriching corporate exposure, the BBA (a 4-year degree in the US) and the MBA have also become the international standard in recent years. The flexible curriculum allows students to tailor their educational program to best fit their professional aspirations.

Earn dual degrees recognized in France and around the world

CEFAM is a very unique school. We are the only French school with AACSB accredited American and Canadian schools to prepare two diplomas- French and American/Canadian. AACSB is the reference certification of worldwide business school.

This demonstrates the value CEFAM puts into intentional international exposure of its programs as a means to reinforce the recognizability of its academic and institutional partners. All US partner universities are also accredited by AACSB. Site web: www.aacsb.edu

AACSB, internationally recognized

In the United States, there is no equivalent of French Ministry of Education, which issues a national ranking of universities. Meanwhile, in the United States nongovernment agencies evaluate the quality of curriculum and an established ranking between universities. Universities are ranked according to their statewide and worldwide reputations.

Universities are ranked according to: national reputation of their researchers and professors, the quality of published papers, the quality of teaching, and the post graduate careers of alumni. Among the organizations validating the quality of university curriculum in the US, the AACSB (Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business) is a reference for business curriculum. The school goes through an evaluation process with numerous criteria prior to being accredited.

This accreditation comes from a desire and eventual demand on behalf of the universities. This AACSB accreditation is highly sought after for every business school. Today it corresponds to the highest achievable level of recognition worldwide. Out of 16,516 business school programs in the world, only 820 are AACSB certified. (Ex: HEC Paris, INSEAD, ESCP Europe...).

Through our signed partnership with ISC Paris, students have the opportunity to earn dual degrees with the following national and international accreditations:

Visa and Master Grade: Visa (certification from the Ministry of Education) validates the quality and content of the material, the pedagogy, and professors. It is validated for a period of 1–5 years for BAC + 3 (Secondary diploma with 3-year higher education credential) and BAC + 5 (Secondary diploma with 5-year higher education credential) programs. Visa gives the authorization to award a diploma recognized by MESRI. The Master Grade is awarded after an extensive audit of institutions awarding a diploma at the level BAC + 5.

The Conference des Grandes Ecoles (CGE) is a group of 229 tertiary establishments who deliver the Master Grade (Management Schools, Engineering schools, Political Science, and other fields) as of October 2019. This certifies academic excellence, employment market adaptation, and specialized education.

AMBA Accreditation: This British accreditation, awarded since 1967, is for MBA programs and has a validity of 5 years. The main criterium for this accreditation is the pertinence of the course content to corporate demand. It certifies the capacity of a Master's program to educate international managers and to offer students access to the job market such as through alumni networks. ISC Paris obtained the AMBA accreditation in 2019 for its Programme Grande Ecole and its MBA in International Business for a validity of 3 years, with renewal in 2022. The AMBA notably highlights strong program direction with excellent professors, and a pedagogical approach including course content that reflects market demand. The AMBA has also maintained the pertinence of the Student Venture model, a distinctive of Grande Ecole Programmes, offering students professional experience that goes beyond their diploma. With this distinction, ISC Paris is a member of an elite group of 24 management schools with this accreditation.

EFMD (European Foundation for Management Development), an attribute of the EPAS label (EFMD program accreditation system), has an auditing system effectuated by Deans of international schools. The criteria include the place and position of the school programs, the structure and means of the programs, the academic body, the pedagogy and learning objectives, evaluation and recruitment procedures, international outreach, and the professional career paths of alumni. The CEFAM Degree is recognized as Level 7

The education both in France and the United States, as well as the internships, and professional assignments, help you obtain the CEFAM diploma which is certified as Level 7 (published in the official journal "Manager des orginisations a l'international" code NSF 310m). This certification is registered in the RNCP (Reperoire National des Certifications Professionelles) and ensures that the coursework is properly evaluated and aligns with future employment prospects. In France, it also guarantees a position and salary corresponding to the higher diploma level received from CEFAM.

This certification is awarded by the Ministry of Employment as well as the Prime Minister. It provides professional verification that validates the CEFAM diploma in France.

(So You Know): Specialized Masters and Grands Ecoles, equivalent to Ivy league schools in the U.S., are recognized in France as certification Level 7 (while CEFAM may not be a Grands Ecoles- we have the same certification level as high ranking schools in France).

CEFAM delivers this Level 7 diploma to their franco-american students at the end of their studies..



The CNCP and the National Register of Professional Certification

The CNCP is the French national commission of professional certification. It is part of the French ministry of employment and is linked to the Prime Minister. This board comprises of various French ministries as well as employees and CEO union organization, chamber of commerce and the representatives of French regions. The aim of the CNCP consists of defining and listing which professional certification links to a specific position in France and records them in the national register.

Only the certifications, verified by a specialized committee and which provide a specific skill set are recorded. They also verify that the recipients of the certificate get a job and salary corresponding to the certification. The records are renewed at least every five years after they review the entire process. The renewal is published by the official journal of the French republic and mentions the level of the certification which ranges from 1-8.

The CNCP also manages the inventory of every certification corresponding to intersecting skill sets.

EAIE - European Association for International Education

CEFAM is a member of EAIE, a non-profit organization whose objective is to bring together the more than 1,800 professionals working in the field of international education. The EAIE helps to create an environment favorable to exchange and mobility. To facilitate this process, the EAIE focuses its work on the professional training and interaction among its members by organizing conferences, professional seminars, and workshops.



ECTS European Credit Transfer System

Since its creation, CEFAM has adopted a modular academic organization of its program. Each successfully completed course module gives the student a volume of "credits". The academic organization of CEFAM allows for the transfer of courses taken and grades earned at CEFAM to the partner university chosen by the student. In Europe, the ECTS (European Credit Transfer System) aims to promote the mobility of students and professors. CEFAM presents its academic programs in accordance with the European Union's ECTS specifications.

CEFAM has been awarded an Erasmus university charter

This system allows students to have access to ERASMUS+ activities and actions and to benefit from academic, professional, and financial support at the European level.

Since its creation, the aim of CEFAM has been to prepare and train students to be the international accountants, managers, and business leaders of tomorrow. This unique program provides the opportunity for students to acquire a greater sense of cultural awareness through language acquisition. Today, CEFAM still pursues this goal of training motivated individuals to work in an international and multicultural environment.

Workshops to Learn How to Market Oneself

Finding an internship or a first job is not always an easy thing to do. First time job seekers are often times faced with many common problems, including not having a network, lacking experience, or not knowing how to market themselves, without taking into account the added complexity of an international search. CEFAM understands these problems and throughout the year provides it students with specific course modules in the form of workshops, mini-conferences in small groups, and/or individual appointments:


- Defining a talent profile
- Developing a career plan
- Optimizing résumés and cover letters
- Participating in mock interviews in French and in English

- Discovering professions and career perspectives
- Learning to make full use of job search tools and digital profiles (ex Linkedin)
- Improving negotiation techniques
- Taking advantage of available research tools on campus

The specific course modules are organized in workshop and mini-conference format in small groups. Individual appointments are also available for students throughout the year, depending on their needs in terms of guidance and advice in their internship search.

Student Career Center (SCC)

This department offers students support in their internship and professional mission searches. Every year, many internship and job offers are available to students via CEFAM's interactive platform. In keeping with the involvement companies have in the development of CEFAM's academic program, internships are an integral part of our curriculum. During the program in France, students are required to gain corporate experience through 3 to 6 month internships throughout the world (United States, Europe, Asia, Australia, and Latin America) and can complete their 4th year in a cooperative education program ("Co-op") in the United States at Northeastern University. Each student benefits from individual guidance to better define his or her career plan.

At CEFAM, students work in a flipped classroom setting. This allows them to prepare material outside of the classroom independently and then use class time to do the harder work of assimilating the knowledge, through problem-solving, discussion, or debates in the presence of the instructor.

Teachers and students work side by side instead of faceto-face. This method presents several advantages, including:

- Strengthening student/teacher relations
- Differentiating teaching methods
- Enabling students to become pro-active in their learning
- Extending and deepening the learning experience



"CEFAM students are all initially registered in what we considered to be our "typical" program; after their 1st semester, however, they can adapt the pace of their progress to their individual needs, whether academic or financial, and choose to personalize their program. CEFAM Admissions

At CEFAM, we welcome students after high school graduation as well as transfer students from other universities. It is required to have a good level of English to enter CEFAM. If you wish to improve your English, you may apply for CEFAM's Foundation Program.

- Once we receive your completed application, you will receive the information needed in order to complete the entrance exam online. For non-native English speakers, the exam consists of:
 - English: grammar, vocabulary, written expression, listening comprehension and speaking (2 hours)
 - Maths (1 hour)
 - Motivation Interview: the interview committee will try to assess your personality and your ability to successfully complete the CEFAM program (30 minutes)

If you are a native English speaker, attended an English-speaking international school, or an International Baccalaureate program, the entrance exam consists of:

- English: analytical reading comprehension and writing
- Maths (1 hour)
- Motivation Interview: the interview committee will try to assess your personality and your ability to successfully complete the CEFAM program (30 minutes)
- You will receive your results within 2 weeks of completion.
 If you are accepted, you may enroll either in January or September intake

Admission into CEFAM's 4th year

- If you have already completed a Bachelor's degree in Business, you may be eligible to enroll at CEFAM for the 4th year and earn our degree in just one year. The admissions process is the same as for first year students, but includes your university transcripts. The entrance exam consists of:
