- Range from 4 days to 6 months, offering flexibility based on academic needs
- Fulfill specific course requirements at partner universities, often satisfying a goal area, major, or minor requirement
- Bring together students from the same university,
 fostering collaboration and shared learning experiences
- May or may not be led by Faculty from the partner institution

CULTURAL

Students experience the best of Lyon's rich heritage, gastronomy, and lifestyle, blending curated activities with free time to explore the city at their own pace.

- Festive Brazilian Farewell Party Celebrate the end of the program with a lively evening of music, dance, and cultural exchange.
- Free Time to Explore Students enjoy dedicated moments to discover Lyon's neighborhoods, museums, cafés, and boutiques, fostering independence and authentic cultural immersion.

ACADEMICS:

Students explore key global topics through interactive workshops led by international faculty:

- International Politics: The EU-Mercosur Deal Alive, in Limbo, or Stillborn?
- International Business: Opportunities and Frictions in the France-Brazil-EU Relationship

Full day trip to Geneva

- Connecting International Politics to the Geneva visit: The UN field trip will place these debates in the multilateral arenas where such norms are negotiated and enforced.
- Connecting International Business to the Geneva visit: The class will also link to the field trip, where students will visit the WTO and ILO in Geneva to see how international business rules and labor standards are negotiated at the global level.

6 to 12 months before the program begins:

Consultation · Proposal Development · Contracts

- CEFAM collaborates with your school Faculty and staff to discuss the program's vision and objectives, explore options, offer insights, and outline available support and services.
- CEFAM crafts a tailored program proposal, detailing included services, student pricing tiers, and key deadlines.
- Confirm the final details of the program proposal.

6 Months before the program begins

Proposal Finalization · Promotion · Student Recruitment

- The Agreement between the school and CEFAM is finalized
- Sign the Agreement
- Your institution promotes the program and recruits students. CEFAM can provide assistance!
- The school keeps CEFAM updated on recruitment progress and estimated student enrollment.



4 Months before the program begins

Confirmation · Preparation

- Deadline for paying a deposit.
- School submits the final roster, including students & Faculty to CEFAM.
- Students apply for visas if required, with CEFAM providing necessary supporting documents.
- CEFAM's team secures on-site reservations and finalizes program logistics.

1 Month prior to departure

Implementation

- Housing assignments are finalized for students and shared with students, Faculty, and the school.
- CEFAM enrolls students & Faculty in health insurance coverage if required.
- CEFAM issues the final invoice to the school and deadline to be paid.
- The school, Faculty, and students participate to a pre-arrival webinar and receive important information.
