Oral Exam Preparation

To enter the 4th year at CEFAM, you will be required to take an oral exam. The oral exam has a few purposes: to test your level of spoken English, evaluate your motivation in attending CEFAM, and understand your professional and educational background.

You might be asked questions such as:

- Why are you interested in attending CEFAM? How does it fit into your future goals?
- What is your educational and professional background? What business experience do you have?
- What do you know about CEFAM? Why are you interested in a French-American program?
- What business classes have you taken? What are your transferrable skills?
- What formal or informal experience do you have in business?

Additionally, you maybe be asked to explain basic marketing or financial concepts.

In terms of your English-speaking ability, you will be evaluated on your oral expression, comprehension, vocabulary, and overall grammar.

Tips to succeed:

- Practice a 2-minute 'pitch' of yourself. Be ready to introduce yourself, why you are interested in the school, and your business-related professional goals.
- Remember that this a professional interview to enter the 4th year at CEFAM. Your
 examiner is evaluating your interest in attending the school as well as your ability
 to meet prerequisites. As such, be ready to explain your educational background
 and why you are interested in pursuing a business degree.
- Dress appropriately and be on time for your interview.
- If you do not understand a question, ask your examiner to repeat or rephrase.
- Research CEFAM! Show a genuine interest in the program and course offerings.
